

### **SOLA SEMINAR SERIES**

#### Talk by Prof. Surajit Sen

On 31st March, Prof. Surajit Sen from the State University of New York, Buffalo, spoke on 'Can a typical urban population survive an airborne pandemic?' at the SoLA Seminar Series hosted by the School of Liberal Arts, IIT Jodhpur. Prof. Sen discussed strategies for urban planners to address and endure airborne pandemics, especially the susceptibility of urban areas to airborne pandemics using the 'agent-based model'.
